

The closest airport to Endicott College in Beverly, Massachusetts is Boston Logan International Airport (BOS), which is about 20 miles away.

Endicott College is also accessible by public transportation and taxis that pick up at commuter rail stations in Beverly and Salem.

To get to Endicott College from Logan International Airport:

Using Public Transit, you can:

- 1). Take the MBTA Blue Line to State, then transfer to the Orange Line to North Station
- 2). From North Station, take the MBTA Commuter Rail to Beverly on the Newburyport/Rockport Line. (Five trains stop in Beverly, the nearest to Endicott is Prides Crossing, but all are within 1.5-4 miles distance to the college campus)
- 3). Get off at Prides Crossing, which is about 1.5 miles from campus, or Beverly Farms, which is about 1.9 miles from campus, Beverly Depot is about 4 miles, and Montserratt about 2.5 miles.
- 4). From one of the Beverly Train Stations, take a taxi Lyft, or Uber to the Endicott College campus

Using Car Service direct to Endicott you can:

- Lyft or Uber \$40-60 (Follow signs for Airport Transfers)
- Taxi \$60 to \$90 (There are taxis available outside each terminal at Boston's Logan Airport.)

Directions to Endicott College

From Logan Boston to Route 128 North:

Follow Route I-93 North to Route I-95 North to Exit 45. Take Route 128 North, towards Gloucester.

From Route 128 North (exit 45 on Route 95 North):

Take Exit 17 (Grapevine Road, Beverly Farms). Turn right off the exit ramp and right again after 1.5 miles onto Haskell Street (by the cemetery). Proceed to the end; at stop sign, turn right onto Hale Street, Route 127 to Endicott College. The main entrance is the second entrance on the right.

Check in at the Public Safety Center (building on left as you come through main gate) and they will direct you **to the School of Visual and Performing Arts**
